4. 4.WB Surf Camp is a local surf camp that offers lessons to a wide array of audiences. On top of that, they support the community by donating to the Karen Beasley Sea Turtle Hospital. Searching on their webpage, how much have they donated to date to this organization?
5. Grandmothers for Peace is a local chapter of a grassroots organization who cares about the welfare of all of our citizens. On their international webpage, they reference the Great Pacific Garbage Patch. This garbage patch is twice the size of what state in the US?
